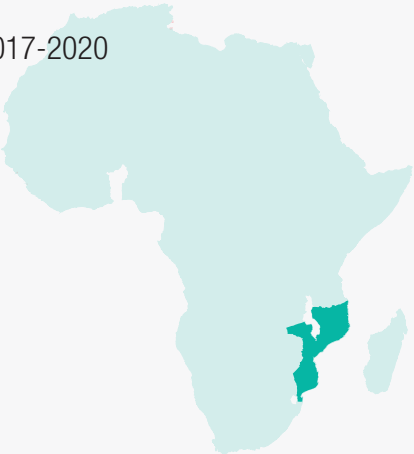

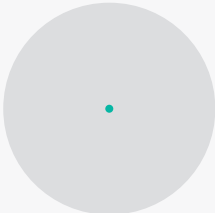
SOCIAL PROTECTION

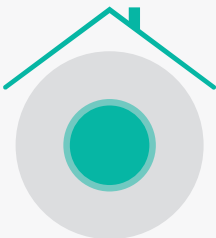

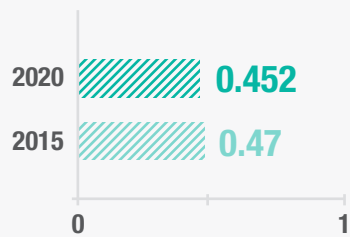
01 % OF HOUSEHOLDS LIVING IN ABSOLUTE POVERTY

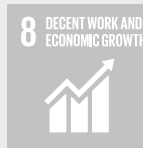
