Social Security Programs for Indonesian Migrant Workers

BPJS Ketenagakerjaan protects Indonesian migrant workers from 6 months before departure, during placement abroad, and after returning to Indonesia.



- Medical care/treatment
- Rehabilitation
- Cash Benefit (for Disability and Death)
- Assistance and Vocational Training post Returning to Indonesia
- Education Scholarship for children







Place of Origin



"Failure to Depart" cases are the main cause of the high number of claims for migrant workers with 1,011 cases since 2017. In 2024, it reached 52.29%.


