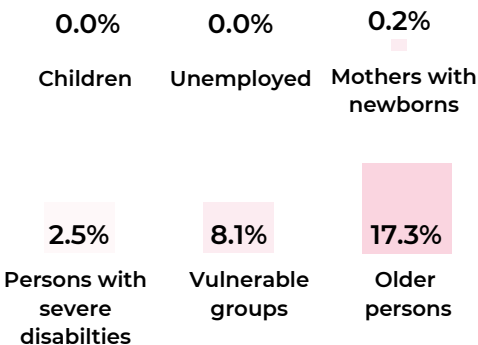

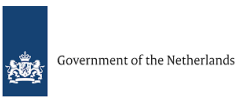
Activities
