2.1 Introductory section

The introductory section offers a general overview of the country's social protection system, providing the user with an overall idea of the system's main features, development, coverage indicators and other relevant information.

2.1.1 Editing the introductory section

To edit this section, use the right side menu on the top of the page:



By clicking on the icon vou can <u>edit the description</u> of the country and the <u>subpages</u> with additional information. The subpages field may be useful to create menus that send the user to other related pages within the SPP.
